Kinuya expresses natural blue like the sea or sky to leather with Japanese traditional indigo dyeing technology.

Kinuya Indigo leather (Dyed with rare natural dye) Kinuya Indigo leather is produced by immersing natural leather into the indigo dyeing liquid many times with natural-plant-indigo-dye technique, and hand-dyeing one by one carefully. The depth of color, variances, and clear color are expressed in the leather as features of Ai-zome(Indigo dye), which is "Kinuya Indigo Leather."

Indigo blue color has been loved by the world for a long time.

In Japan, Sukumo, produced by fermenting the Indigo plant since a long time ago, is used as a dye. From the mid-Edo era to today, Tokushima is a major production area of Tade indigo plants, the material for the dye. Almost all of the materials of ai dyed throughout Japan use Sukumo that is cultivated and produced in Tokushima prefecture.
